

HOUSE No. 877.

[Bill accompanying the petition of James F. Carey for legislation to regulate the number of brakemen which railroad companies shall place upon freight trains, and relative to cabooses. Railroads. February 4.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To regulate the Number of Brakemen which Railroad Companies shall place on Freight Trains, and relative to Cabooses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. Section two hundred of chapter one hun-
2 dred and eleven of the Revised Laws is hereby amended
3 by inserting after the word "brakeman," in the seventh
4 line, the words : — for at least every ten cars in a freight
5 train, and ; and by inserting after the word "brake,"
6 in the ninth line, the words : — and shall be a car of not
7 less than eight wheels. No conductor or other person in
8 charge of the train shall be considered a brakeman for
9 the purposes of this section.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
