

HOUSE No. 965.

[Bill accompanying the petition of Charles P. Anderson and others for legislation relative to the board of aldermen of the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs and Election Laws sitting jointly. February 5.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To provide for Enlarging the Membership of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of aldermen of the city of
2 Boston shall consist of twenty-five members, one from
3 each legally established ward of said city.

1 SECTION 2. The manner of nominating and electing
2 members of said board shall be such as is already estab-
3 lished by existing statutes, except that each ward division
4 shall constitute an aldermanic district, both for purposes
5 of nomination and election.

1 SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with
2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
