In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To provide Relief for the Members of the Societe St. Jean Baptiste de West Boylston, Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Each individual member of the Societe
2 St. Jean Baptiste de West Boylston, Massachusetts, who
3 was in good standing upon the books of said society on
4 the first day of October, nineteen hundred and one, shall
5 be entitled to the sum of one hundred eighty dollars.
6 Said sum shall be paid through the metropolitan water
7 and sewerage board to each said member upon his proof
8 of claim thereto, and shall be taken from the appropria-
9 tion for the metropolitan water supply.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
