Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To provide Relief for the Individual Members of the Society St. Jean Baptiste de West Boylston, Massachusetts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Each individual member of the Society  
2 St. Jean Baptiste de West Boylston, Massachusetts, who  
3 was in good standing upon the books of said society on  
4 the first day of October, nineteen hundred and one, shall  
5 be reimbursed from the treasury of the Commonwealth  
6 in a sum equal to the amount paid by him into the  
7 treasury of said society from the date of his initiation  
8 to the said first day of October, nineteen hundred and  
9 one. Said sum to be paid each said member through  
10 the metropolitan and sewerage board upon his proof of  
11 claim thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
