

[Bill accompanying the petition of George A. Butman, treasurer, for legislation to authorize the Framingham Union Street Railway Company to act as a common carrier of merchandise. Street Railways. February 6]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To authorize the Framingham Union Street Railway Company to act as a Common Carrier of Merchandise.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Framingham Union Street Railway
2 Company is hereby authorized to act as a common carrier
3 of coal, market produce, ice, building materials, baggage
4 and merchandise upon or over any street, highway or
5 private land upon which it may be authorized to construct
6 its tracks or operate its cars: *provided, however,* that
7 said company shall not so act in any city or town until
8 authorized so to do by the board of aldermen or select-
9 men thereof; and *provided, further,* that said company
10 shall be subject to such ordinances or by-laws as may
11 from time to time be made by any such city or town, and
12 shall also be subject to the provisions of chapter seventy-
13 three of the Public Statutes, and of all other laws relating
14 to common carriers.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
