## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

## AN ACT

To authorize the Framingham Union Street Railway Company to act as a Common Carrier of Merchandise.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The Framingham Union Street Railway
- 2 Company is hereby authorized to act as a common carrier
- 3 of coal, market produce, ice, building materials, baggage
- 4 and merchandise upon or over any street, highway or
- 5 private land upon which it may be authorized to construct
- 6 its tracks or operate its cars: provided, however, that
- 7 said company shall not so act in any city or town until
- 8 authorized so to do by the board of aldermen or select-
- 9 men thereof; and provided, further, that said company
- 10 shall be subject to such ordinances or by-laws as may
- 11 from time to time be made by any such city or town, and
- 12 shall also be subject to the provisions of chapter seventy-
- 13 three of the Public Statutes, and of all other laws relating
- 14 to common carriers.
  - 1 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
