### RESOLVE

In Favor of Ellen Ford.

1     *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth an annuity of five hun-  
3 dred dollars for the term of five years to Ellen Ford of  
4 Cambridge, whose husband was killed while in the per-  
5 formance of labor on the marble work in memorial hall,  
6 at the state house, Boston, in the month of December,  
7 nineteen hundred and one, said annuity to commence  
8 on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and two,  
9 and to be paid in equally quarterly instalments. Should  
10 the said Ellen Ford remarry or die the annuity, as afore-  
11 said, shall be paid for the remainder of the term to her  
12 children.
