AN ACT

To confirm a Certain Agreement between the City of Boston and the Boston Terminal Company relating to the Construction of Cove Street Bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The agreement signed by the mayor of
2 the city of Boston, claiming to act for said city, and by
3 the vice chairman of the Boston Terminal Company,
4 on behalf of the trustees of said company, claiming to
5 act for said company, relating to the construction of
6 Cove street bridge, so called, over the lands of said com-
7 pany, dated January thirty-first, nineteen hundred and
8 two, is hereby ratified and confirmed as a contract be-
9 tween said city of Boston and said terminal company;
10 and said city and company may do the things therein
11 agreed upon and as therein specified.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
