RESOLVE

In favor of Samuel Hillman of North Adams.

- 1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to Samuel Hillman of
3 North Adams an annuity of three hundred and sixty dol-
4 lars, payable in equal quarterly instalments, for the term
5 of five years, from and after the first day of January in
6 the year nineteen hundred and two, for injuries sustained
7 while he was employed at the Hoosac Tunnel, the cause
8 of said injury being an explosion of glycerine negligently
9 left by employees of the Commonwealth.
- 10 Chapter ten of the resolves of the year eighteen hun-
11 dred and ninety-nine is hereby repealed.
