### AN ACT

Relative to the Annual Reports of Treasurers of  
Certain Cities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city treasurer in every city  
2 of fifty thousand inhabitants or more shall include  
3 in his annual report an alphabetical list of the  
4 names of all persons paid a salary or part of a  
5 salary from the city treasury, and a statement of  
6 the number of laborers and all other persons  
7 paid by wages or otherwise than by salary, and  
8 if there is more than one department in the city,  
9 the names and the numbers on the lists so pub-  
10 lished shall be arranged by departments. The  
11 list shall give the residence, by street and num-  
12 ber, nature of service, civil service rating, if any,  
13 date of entry into service, date of end of service,  
14 amount of salary or wages and a statement of the

15 decrease or increase thereof during the previous  
16 year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
