## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

### RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Essex.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
- 2 priated for the expenses of the county of Essex for the
- 3 year nineteen hundred and two :—
- 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding seven
- 5 thousand dollars.
- 6 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
- 7 law, a sum not exceeding thirty thousand dollars.
- 8 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-
- 9 ceeding fifteen thousand five hundred dollars.
- 10 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
- 11 a sum not exceeding forty-two thousand dollars.
- 12 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and sup-
- 13 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum
- 14 not exceeding fifty-six thousand dollars.
- 15 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not ex-
- 16 ceeding thirty-five thousand dollars.
- 17 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
- 18 courts, a sum not exceeding twenty-two thousand dollars.
- 19 For trial justices, a sum not exceeding five thousand
- 20 dollars.

21 For transportation expenses of county and associate  
22 commissioners, a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars.

23 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of  
24 the insane, a sum not exceeding ten thousand five hundred  
25 dollars.

26 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-  
27 ing six thousand dollars.

28 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-  
29 ings, a sum not exceeding eighteen thousand dollars.

30 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other  
31 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the  
32 same, a sum not exceeding fourteen thousand dollars.

33 For highways, bridges and land damages, a sum not  
34 exceeding thirty thousand dollars.

35 For law libraries, a sum not exceeding two thousand  
36 dollars.

37 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding eight thousand  
38 dollars.

39 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-  
40 rent year, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars.

41 And the county commissioners of said county are  
42 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said county  
43 for the current year, in the manner provided by law, the  
44 sum of two hundred and fifty-eight thousand dollars, to  
45 be expended, together with the cash balance on hand and  
46 the receipts from other sources, for the above purposes.
