RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Northampton
Insane Hospital.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 thirty-five hundred dollars, to be expended under the
4 direction of the trustees of the Northampton Insane
5 Hospital in providing a new boiler and new machinery
6 for the carpenter and machine shops at said hospital.
7 The above amount shall be paid from any receipts that
8 may be paid into the treasury of the Commonwealth by
9 said hospital.
