### RESOLVE

In Favor of Lemuel D. Burr and Anna Burr of Cambridge.

1   *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary  
3 revenue, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to  
4 Lemuel D. Burr and Anna Burr, children of the late  
5 Lemuel Burr of Cambridge, who was a member of the  
6 Ponkapoag tribe of Indians, for their support.
