RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Middlesex.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
2 priated for the expenses of the county of Middlesex for
3 the year nineteen hundred and two :—
- 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding forty-
5 seven thousand five hundred dollars.
- 6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
7 sixty-one thousand dollars.
- 8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
9 law, a sum not exceeding thirty-four thousand seven hun-
10 dred dollars.
- 11 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-
12 ceeding sixty-eight thousand dollars.
- 13 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
14 a sum not exceeding seventy-three thousand dollars.
- 15 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and sup-
16 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum
17 not exceeding one hundred and thirty-six thousand dol-
18 lars.
- 19 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not ex-
20 ceeding thirty-two thousand dollars.
- 21 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
22 courts, a sum not exceeding forty-eight thousand dollars.

23 For trial justices, a sum not exceeding three thousand
24 dollars.

25 For transportation expenses of county and associate
26 commissioners, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars.

27 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of
28 the insane, a sum not exceeding twelve thousand five hun-
29 dred dollars.

30 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-
31 ing eight thousand dollars.

32 For building county buildings, a sum not exceeding
33 eight thousand dollars.

34 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
35 ings, a sum not exceeding twenty-nine thousand dollars.

36 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other
37 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the
38 same, a sum not exceeding forty-three thousand dollars.

39 For highways, including state highways, bridges and
40 land damages, a sum not exceeding forty thousand dol-
41 lars.

42 For law libraries, a sum not exceeding two thousand
43 dollars.

44 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding twenty-one
45 thousand dollars.

46 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-
47 rent year, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars.

48 And the county commissioners of said county are
49 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said county
50 for the current year, in the manner provided by law, the
51 sum of five hundred and sixty thousand one hundred
52 thirty dollars and seven cents, to be expended, together
53 with the cash balance on hand and the receipts from other
54 sources, for the above purposes.
