RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Norfolk.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
2 priated for the expenses of the county of Norfolk for
3 the year nineteen hundred and two:—
4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding four
5 thousand dollars.
6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
7 fifteen thousand dollars.
8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by
9 law, a sum not exceeding seventeen thousand seven
10 hundred dollars.
11 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-
12 ceeding eighteen thousand dollars.
13 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
14 a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars.
15 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and sup-
16 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum
17 not exceeding twenty-six thousand dollars.
18 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not ex-
19 ceeding eighteen thousand dollars.
20 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
21 courts, a sum not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars.

22 For transportation expenses of county and associate
23 commissioners, a sum not exceeding three hundred dol-
24 lars.

25 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of
26 the insane, a sum not exceeding four thousand five hun-
27 dred dollars.

28 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-
29 ing two thousand five hundred dollars.

30 For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-
31 ings, a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars.

32 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other
33 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the
34 same, a sum not exceeding eleven thousand dollars.

35 For highways, bridges and land damages, a sum not
36 exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars.

37 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding four thou-
38 sand dollars.

39 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-
40 rent year, a sum not exceeding four thousand dollars.

41 And the county commissioners of said county are
42 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said
43 county for the current year, in the manner provided by
44 law, the sum of one hundred and forty thousand four
45 hundred seventeen dollars and sixty-one cents, to be ex-
46 pended, together with the cash balance on hand and the
47 receipts from other sources, for the above purposes.
