RESOLVE

In Favor of Charles E. Mitchell.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to Charles E. Mitchell
3 the sum of three thousand dollars, the said Mitchell
4 being a ward-room steward on the training ship "Enter-
5 prise," who, on the seventh day of August in the year
6 nineteen hundred and one, received injuries while in the
7 discharge of his duty which necessitated the amputation
8 of his left foot.
