### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to pay a Certain Sum of Money to Margaret A. and Katharine Alexander.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized to  
2 pay to Margaret A. and Katharine Alexander, daughters  
3 of Richard H. Alexander, late an employee of the sanitary  
4 division of the street department, a sum of money not  
5 exceeding one-half of the annual salary of said Richard  
6 H. Alexander; *provided*, that the sum hereby authorized  
7 to be paid shall not exceed the amount to which said  
8 employee should have been entitled if he had lived and  
9 continued to serve as such employee until the first day  
10 of February next succeeding the date of his death.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
