AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Operating the Steamer
"Lexington" in the Enforcement of the Laws
relative to Fisheries.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of five thousand dollar is
2 hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 to meet the expense of operating the steamer
5 "Lexington," which is under the charge of the
6 chief of the Massachusetts district police, and is
7 used for the enforcement of the fish laws of the
8 Commonwealth. [Revised Laws, chap. 91.]

(Appropriation 1901, \$7,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
