AN ACT

To establish the Salaries of the Justice and Clerk
of the Second District Court of Plymouth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the justice of the
2 second district court of Plymouth shall be fifteen
3 hundred dollars a year, to be so allowed from the
4 first day of January in the year nineteen hundred
5 and two.

1 SECTION 2. The salary of the clerk of the
2 second district court of Plymouth shall be eight
3 hundred dollars a year, to be so allowed from
4 the first day of January in the year nineteen
5 hundred and two.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
