

HOUSE No. 1304.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Falmouth to extend its Water Works and issue Additional Bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter sixty-six of the acts of the year
2 eighteen hundred and ninety-eight is hereby amended by
3 substituting in the sixth line of section thirteen for the
4 words "one hundred and fifty," the words:— one hun-
5 dred and seventy-five, — so that the amount of bonds
6 authorized by said section, to be issued, shall be one
7 hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Falmouth, after the purchase
2 of and payment for the franchise and corporate property of
3 the Falmouth Water Company, may, for the purpose of

4 extending its water works, issue bonds to an amount not
5 exceeding thirty thousand dollars, in addition to the
6 amount authorized by said section thirteen, as amended
7 by this act. Such bonds shall be of the form and subject
8 to the provisions specified in said section thirteen.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
