### RESOLVE

To authorize an Expert Investigation of the Acoustic Properties of the Chamber of the House of Representatives.

1     *Resolved*, That the speaker of the house of representa-  
2     tives, the clerk of the house of representatives and the  
3     sergeant-at-arms be, and they are hereby constituted a  
4     committee, and are authorized to employ such experts  
5     and to incur such expenditures as may be necessary to  
6     properly investigate the acoustic properties of the cham-  
7     ber of the house of representatives, with a view to the  
8     improvement of the same, and may expend in carrying  
9     out the provisions of this resolve a sum not exceeding  
10  one thousand dollars.
