AN ACT

Relative to the construction at Dedham of a Building  
for the Registries of Deeds and of Probate and for  
the Probate Court for the County of Norfolk.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter two hundred  
2 and eighty-four of the acts of the year nineteen  
3 hundred and one is hereby amended by striking  
4 out in lines six to ten, both inclusive, the words  
5 "Such approval shall not be given until the board  
6 is convinced that the cost of the building, ready  
7 for the use of said registries and court, and of the  
8 offices incident thereto, will not exceed the sum of

9 two hundred thousand dollars," so as to read as  
10 follows:—

11 *Section 2.* No contract shall be made for the  
12 construction of said building until plans have been  
13 submitted by the county commissioners to a board  
14 consisting of the judge of probate, the register of  
15 probate, and the register of deeds, for the county  
16 of Norfolk, and have been approved by said board.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
