AN ACT

Relative to Loans of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter four hun-
2 dred and seventy-one of the acts of the year
3 eighteen hundred and ninety-eight is hereby
4 amended by striking out all after the word
5 "thereof" in line ten of said section.

1 SECTION 2. All bonds of the city of Boston
2 heretofore issued are hereby ratified and confirmed
3 as legal bonds and obligations of said city; and
4 any bonds of said city heretofore offered for sale
5 for terms not exceeding forty years may be issued
6 in accordance with the offer.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
