Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

Relative to the Construction of the Subway and  
Tunnel provided for by Chapter Five Hundred of  
the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and  
Ninety-seven.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter five  
2 hundred of the acts of the year eighteen hundred  
3 and ninety-seven relative to the construction of a  
4 tunnel to East Boston and a subway under Cam-  
5 bridge street are extended so that the East Bos-  
6 ton tunnel and the Cambridge street subway may  
7 connect with the existing subway and with each

8 other at such points and in such manner, whether  
9 at grade or otherwise as the Boston transit com-  
10 mission may deem that the public interests require.

1 SECTION 2. The term of office of the mem-  
2 bers of said commission is hereby extended for  
3 three years from the first day of July in the year  
4 nineteen hundred and two.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of chapter five  
2 hundred and forty-eight of the acts of the year  
3 eighteen hundred and ninety-four and said chapter  
4 five hundred of the acts of the year eighteen hun-  
5 dred and ninety-seven and the acts in amendment  
6 of or in addition to said acts shall apply to said  
7 commission and the members thereof during said  
8 extended term, and said commission shall have  
9 the powers and be subject to the duties therein  
10 set forth.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon  
2 its passage.
