AN ACT

To provide for the Retirement of the Justices of the  
Municipal Court of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The chief justice and any associ-  
2 ate justice of the municipal court of the City of  
3 Boston, who shall resign his office after having  
4 attained the age of seventy years, and after having  
5 served in said court at least ten consecutive years,  
6 shall during the remainder of his natural life re-  
7 ceive an amount equal to three-fourths of the  
8 salary by law payable to him at the time of his  
9 resignation, to be paid by the county of Suffolk in

10 the same manner as the salaries of acting justices  
11 are paid.

1 SECTION 2. The chief justice and any associate  
2 justice of said court who, after having attained  
3 the age of sixty years, and after having served in  
4 said court at least fifteen consecutive years, shall  
5 have become incapacitated from full discharge of  
6 his duties as justice by reason of sickness or  
7 otherwise, may, with the approval of the governor  
8 and council, resign his office under the provisions  
9 of this section, and shall thereupon during the re-  
10 mainder of his natural life receive an amount  
11 equal to three-fourths of the salary which was by  
12 law payable to him at the time of his resignation,  
13 to be paid by the county of Suffolk in the same  
14 manner as the salaries of acting justices are paid.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
