RESOLVE

Relative to the Acceptance by the Commonwealth of a
Memorial of Roger Wolcott.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor and council may, in the
2 exercise of their discretion, accept for the Common-
3 wealth the tender of a memorial of Roger Wolcott, late
4 governor of the Commonwealth, and, in the further
5 exercise of their discretion, grant to the committee and
6 their successors in charge of such memorial a suitable
7 site and location for the erection thereof upon the
8 grounds adjoining the state house.
