Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To prohibit Trust Companies from establishing or maintaining Branch Offices.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. No trust company incorporated
- 2 under the laws of this Commonwealth shall estab-
- 3 lish or maintain more than one place of business
- 4 within the Commonwealth for receiving deposits,
- 5 paying checks, or carrying on the other business
- 6 of the company: provided, however, that a trust
- 7 company may carry on its business in more than
- 8 one room of the same building or of any adjoining
- 9 building.

1 Section 2. If any trust company violates the 2 provisions of section one of this act the board of 3 commissioners of savings banks shall apply to the 4 supreme judicial court, which shall have jurisdiction in equity of such application, for an injunction to restrain such company, in whole or in part, 7 from further proceeding with its business. The 8 court may appoint one or more receivers to take 9 possession of the property and effects of such 10 company, subject to such directions as may from 11 time to time be given by the court.
