AN ACT

To prohibit the Manufacture of Liquid or Compressed Air and of Certain Explosive Gases in Any Part of a Building occupied for Living Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No person shall manufacture  
2 liquid or compressed air or gases, except acety-  
3 lene gas and other gases used for illuminating  
4 purposes, and shall not manufacture other articles  
5 of which such explosive substances are compo-  
6 nent parts, in a cellar, room, or apartment of a

7 tenement or dwelling house occupied in whole or  
8 in part by persons or families for living purposes.

1 SECTION 2. Whoever violates any of the  
2 provisions of this act shall be punished by fine  
3 not exceeding five hundred dollars, or by impris-  
4 onment not exceeding one year, or by both such  
5 fine and imprisonment.
