### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to pay a Sum of Money to the Widow of John A. Kidney.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby au-  
2 thorized to pay to the widow of John A. Kidney,  
3 late an employee of the auditing department of the  
4 city of Boston, a sum of money not exceeding  
5 one-half of the annual salary of said John A.  
6 Kidney, provided that the sum hereby authorized  
7 to be paid shall not exceed the amount to which  
8 said employee should have been entitled if he had  
9 lived and continued to serve as such employee  
10 until the first day of February next succeeding  
11 the date of his death.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
