### RESOLVE

To provide for the Purchase of Land for the Use of the  
Worcester Insane Asylum.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding  
3 twenty-five thousand dollars to be expended by the  
4 trustees of the Worcester insane asylum, with the ap-  
5 proval of the state board of insanity, for the purchase  
6 of not less than five hundred acres of land for the use of  
7 said asylum.
