RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Massachusetts State Sanatorium.

1 *Resolved*, That the following sums be allowed and
2 paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, from the
3 ordinary revenue, for improvements at the Massachu-
4 setts State Sanatorium, to be expended under the
5 direction of the trustees thereof, namely: a sum not
6 exceeding two thousand dollars for the purchase of land
7 in the vicinity of the sanatorium; a sum not exceeding
8 five hundred dollars for repairing the roads leading to
9 the sanatorium.
