RESOLVE

To provide for an Investigation and a Report by the State Board of Agriculture as to the Feasibility and Probable Cost of producing Vaccine Lymph at the Massachusetts Agricultural College for Free Distribution within the Commonwealth.

1 *Resolved*, That the state board of agriculture is hereby
2 authorized and directed to investigate as to the feasibility
3 and probable cost of producing vaccine lymph at the
4 Massachusetts agricultural college, for free distribution
5 within the Commonwealth, and to report the result of
6 such investigation, together with such recommendations
7 as the board may consider advisable, to the general court
8 on or before the fifteenth day of January in the year
9 nineteen hundred and three.
