AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Removal of Wrecks from Tide Waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of three thousand dollars
2 is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary
4 revenue, for expenses in connection with the re-
5 moval of wrecks and other obstructions from the
6 tide waters, as provided for in section twenty-two
7 of chapter ninety-seven of the Revised Laws,
8 during the year ending on the thirty-first day of
9 December, nineteen hundred and three.

(Appropriation 1902, \$3,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
