AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Weymouth to make an  
Additional Water Loan.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Weymouth, for the  
2 purpose of extending its system of water works,  
3 as authorized by the provisions of chapter one  
4 hundred and seventy-four of the acts of the year  
5 eighteen hundred and eighty-one, may, from time  
6 to time, during the term of ten years from the  
7 passage of this act, issue notes, bonds, or scrip, to  
8 be denominated on the face thereof, Weymouth  
9 Water Loan, to an amount not exceeding fifty

10 thousand dollars in addition to the amount hereto-  
11 fore authorized by law to be issued by said town  
12 for the purposes of the act aforesaid. Said notes,  
13 bonds or scrip shall be issued upon the same  
14 terms and conditions and with the same powers  
15 as are provided in said act for the issue of the  
16 Weymouth water loan by said town: *provided*,  
17 *however*, that the said town may sell said securi-  
18 ties at public or private sale, or may pledge the  
19 same for money borrowed for the purposes of this  
20 act, upon such terms and conditions as it may  
21 deem proper: *provided, also*, that the whole  
22 amount of such notes, bonds or scrip issued by  
23 said town, together with those heretofore author-  
24 ized to be issued by said town for the purposes  
25 named in said chapter one hundred and seventy-  
26 four, shall not in any event exceed the sum of five  
27 hundred and fifteen thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
