In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

AN ACT

Relative to Granting Licenses for the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No city or town which since  
2 eighteen hundred and ninety-seven has voted an-  
3 nually to grant licenses for the sale of intoxicating  
4 liquors shall hereafter vote upon the question of  
5 granting such licenses except once in every four  
6 years.

1 SECTION 2. No city or town which hereafter  
2 votes to grant licenses for the sale of intoxicating  
3 liquors annually for five consecutive years shall  
4 thereafter vote upon the question of granting  
5 such licenses except once in every four years.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
