Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

RESOLVE

To provide for a Gymnasium and Other Improvements at
the State Normal School at Bridgewater.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 fifty-eight thousand and seven hundred dollars, for the
4 following improvements connected with the state normal
5 school at Bridgewater: for constructing a building for a
6 gymnasium and for grading the grounds in connection
7 with it and furnishing it with suitable apparatus, a sum
8 not exceeding fifty-five thousand dollars; for the pur-
9 chase of land and the erection of a suitable building for
10 the storage of coal, a sum not exceeding one thousand
11 and two hundred dollars; and for the installation of an
12 electric plant for lighting all the school buildings, a sum
13 not exceeding two thousand and five hundred dollars,
14 the entire amount to be expended under the direction
15 of the state board of education.
