AN ACT

Relative to the Equipment of Infantry Regiments
of the Militia for Service in the Field.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The quartermaster-general shall
2 provide for each infantry regiment the tools,
3 wagons, harnesses, camp equipments, and such
4 other articles as are allowed to an infantry regi-
5 ment in the service of the United States for field
6 service, to equip said regiments of the organized
7 militia for active duty in the field.

1 SECTION 2. To provide means to carry into
2 effect the provision of the preceding section, the
3 necessary money to cover the cost of such equip-
4 ment, to be used hereunder, is hereby appropriated
5 out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise
6 appropriated.
