AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for operating the North Metropolitan System of Sewerage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding one hun-
2 dred twenty-two thousand six hundred dollars is
3 hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treas-
4 ury of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary
5 revenue, for the purpose of providing for the cost
6 of the maintenance and operation of the system
7 of sewage disposal for the cities of Boston,
8 Cambridge, Somerville, Malden, Chelsea, Wo-
9 burn, Medford, Melrose and Everett, and the
10 towns of Stoneham, Winchester, Arlington and
11 Belmont, known as the north metropolitan sys-
12 tem, during the year ending on the thirty-first
13 day of December nineteen hundred and three.
