AN ACT

Relative to the Crossings of Railroads and Public  
Ways in East Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter four hun-  
2 dred and sixty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred  
3 is hereby amended by striking out the word  
4 "three," in the last line of said section, and by  
5 substituting the word: — six, — in lieu thereof.

1 SECTION 2. Nothing in said chapter four hun-  
2 dred and sixty-two nor in chapter three hundred

3 and ninety of the acts of the year eighteen hun-  
4 dred and ninety-nine shall be construed to limit  
5 or restrict the time within which the commission-  
6 ers, referred to in said two acts, may report to the  
7 superior court for the county of Suffolk upon the  
8 matters referred to them under said acts.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
