AN ACT

Relative to the Fire Department of the City of  
Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The members of the fire depart-  
2 ment of the city of Boston shall, once in every  
3 six days, be granted a leave of absence of twenty-  
4 four consecutive hours.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
