## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

### AN ACT

Relative to the transportation of Scholars of Academies by Street Railway Companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section seventy-two of chapter one hundred  
2 and twelve of the Revised Laws is hereby amended  
3 by inserting after the words "public schools,"  
4 in lines two and three thereof, the words:— and  
5 academies,— so that said portion of said section,  
6 when amended, shall read:—

7 *Section 72.* The rates of fare charged by street  
8 or elevated railway companies in this Common-  
9 wealth for the transportation of scholars of the

10 public schools and academies between any given  
11 point from or to which it is necessary for them to  
12 ride in travelling to and from the schoolhouses in  
13 which they attend school, and their homes,  
14 whether such schoolhouses are located in the city  
15 or town in which the scholars reside or in any  
16 other city or town, shall not exceed one-half the  
17 regular fare charged by such street or elevated  
18 railway company for the transportation of other  
19 passengers between said points.
