[Bill accompanying the petition of S. B. Ryan for legislation to provide for the abolition of grade crossings in the city of Lawrence. Railroads. Feb. 4.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

AN ACT

To provide for abolishing Certain Grade Crossings
in the City of Lawrence.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The grade crossings now existing
2 in the city of Lawrence at the points where the
3 line of the Boston and Maine railroad is crossed
4 by Essex street, by Water street, by Broadway,
5 by Merrimack street and by Andover street shall
6 be abolished, and the said streets shall be placed
7 under the railroad tracks at the said points, in ac-
8 cordance with the laws relative to the abolition of
9 grade crossings.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
