AN ACT

To authorize the Georgetown, Rowley and Ipswich Street Railway Company to transmit and sell Electricity for Domestic Purposes to the Owner or Owners of the "Ox Pasture" Hill in the Town of Rowley.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Georgetown, Rowley and  
2 Ipswich Street Railway Company is hereby author-  
3 ized to construct and operate lines for the trans-  
4 mission of electricity in the town of Rowley for  
5 the purpose of furnishing light, heat and power

6 for domestic uses and purposes to the owner or  
7 owners of "Ox Pasture" hill in said town, and to  
8 erect and maintain upon the streets and highways  
9 and private land in said town such posts and  
10 other fixtures as may be necessary to sustain the  
11 wires and other fixtures of its lines, and may  
12 sell electricity to said owner or owners for such  
13 purposes.

1 SECTION 2. Said company shall, however, be  
2 subject to all general laws of this Commonwealth  
3 relating to the erection and maintenance and  
4 operation of lines for the transmission of elec-  
5 tricity for lighting, heating or power.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
