AN ACT

Relative to the Maintenance of Public Ways in or near the State Colony for the Insane.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The expense of the care and
2 maintenance of the public ways in or bordering
3 upon the land of the state colony for the insane in
4 the towns of Westminster and Gardner shall be
5 borne by the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
