AN ACT

To legalize and confirm Certain Proceedings of a
Special Town Meeting of the Town of Winchester.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Bonds of the town of Winchester
2 may be issued and made payable as specified by
3 vote of the town at a special town meeting held
4 on the ninth day of June in the year nineteen
5 hundred and two, and it shall not be necessary to
6 establish a sinking fund for the payment of the
7 said bonds.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
