### RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Hampden.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-  
2 priated for the expenses of the county of Hampden for  
3 the year nineteen hundred and three : —  
4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding  
5 nine thousand dollars.  
6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding  
7 thirty-five thousand dollars.  
8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by  
9 law, a sum not exceeding fourteen thousand dollars.  
10 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-  
11 ceeding twelve thousand dollars.  
12 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,  
13 a sum not exceeding twenty-three thousand dollars.  
14 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and sup-  
15 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum  
16 not exceeding twenty-six thousand dollars.  
17 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not  
18 exceeding five thousand dollars.  
19 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior  
20 courts, a sum not exceeding twenty-one thousand dollars.

21 For transportation expenses of county and associate  
22 commissioners, a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars.

23 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments  
24 of the insane, a sum not exceeding five thousand five  
25 hundred dollars.

26 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-  
27 ing five thousand dollars.

28 For repairing, furnishing and improving county  
29 buildings, a sum not exceeding six thousand dollars.

30 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings,  
31 other than jails and houses of correction, and for care of  
32 the same, a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars.

33 For highways, bridges and land damages, a sum not  
34 exceeding ten thousand dollars.

35 For law libraries, a sum not exceeding two thousand  
36 five hundred dollars.

37 For truant schools, a sum not exceeding seven thou-  
38 sand dollars.

39 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the  
40 current year, a sum not exceeding six thousand eight  
41 hundred eighty dollars and sixty-six cents.

42 And the county commissioners of said county are  
43 hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said  
44 county for the current year, in the manner provided by  
45 law, the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars,  
46 to be expended, together with the cash balance on hand  
47 and the receipts from other sources, for the above  
48 purposes.
