In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three.

---

### AN ACT

To Direct the State Board of Health to investigate and report on the Dumping of Garbage and Rubbish into the Harbors and along the Seacoast of Massachusetts Bay.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The state board of health is  
2 hereby directed to investigate and report on the  
3 dumping of garbage and rubbish in the harbors  
4 and along the seacoast of Massachusetts Bay and  
5 to report to the legislature their recommendations  
6 for providing suitable inspection and regulation  
7 of the same and for the purpose of preventing the  
8 strewing of the shores with offensive material  
9 and thereby creating a nuisance.

1 SECTION 2. To carry out the purposes of this  
2 act, said board of health is authorized to expend

3 a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars which  
4 sum is hereby appropriated to be paid out of the  
5 treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary  
6 revenue.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
