AN ACT

Making an Additional Appropriation for Expenses
of the General Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of ten thousand dollars
2 is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary
4 revenue, for authorized expenses of the present
5 general court, to include clerical assistance to
6 committees authorized to employ the same; said
7 sum to be in addition to the ten thousand dollars
8 appropriated by chapter one of the acts of the
9 present year. [Revised Laws, chapter 6.]

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
