AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to pay a Certain Sum of Money to Francis V. Griggs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized
2 to pay to Francis V. Griggs, widow of Edward W.
3 Griggs, late an employee in the sewer department of the
4 city of Boston, a sum of money not exceeding one-half
5 of the annual salary of said Edward W. Griggs: *pro-*
6 *vided*, that the sum hereby authorized to be paid shall
7 not exceed the amount to which said employee would
8 have been entitled if he had lived and continued to serve
9 as such employee until the first day of February next
10 succeeding the date of his death.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
