AN ACT

Relative to a High School Building in the City of
Brockton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The high school building com-
2 mission appointed by the mayor of the city of
3 Brockton by virtue of an order of the city coun-
4 cil of that city approved by the mayor on the
5 twenty-seventh day of December, in the year nine-
6 teen hundred and two, which appointment and
7 order are hereby ratified and confirmed, is hereby
8 authorized, in the name and behalf of the city, to
9 erect within a reasonable time upon the land here-
10 tofore designated by the city for the purpose, a
11 building for a high school for the city and for
12 other purposes incidental thereto, all in accor-
13 dance with said order; and said commission shall

14 not expend or contract to expend more than the
15 sum specified in said order, unless such excess of
16 expenditure shall first be authorized by the city
17 council of the city.

1 SECTION 2. The said commission shall remain
2 in existence a sufficient time to accomplish the
3 purposes of this act, and any vacancy therein
4 shall be filled by appointment by the mayor and
5 confirmation by the board of aldermen as provided
6 for the original appointments. The commission
7 shall annually, and whenever required by the
8 mayor or by the city council, make and present
9 in writing a report of all their acts and proceed-
10 ings, and of the condition and progress of the
11 work. They shall receive such compensation as
12 the city council shall determine, and shall not be
13 interested individually, either directly or indirectly,
14 in the work hereby directed to be done.

1 SECTION 3. For the purpose of carrying out
2 the work specified in said order and in this act,
3 the city treasurer of the said city is hereby author-
4 ized to borrow the sum of one hundred and eighty
5 thousand dollars, and to issue bonds, notes or
6 scrip of the city to that amount at the times and
7 in the manner following, to wit.: the indebtedness
8 to be incurred hereunder during the year nineteen
9 hundred and three shall not exceed the sum of
10 one hundred thousand dollars; the bonds, notes
11 or scrip issued therefor shall be dated May first,
12 nineteen hundred and three, and shall be denomi-

13 nated on their face "Brockton High School Loan,
14 1903." The indebtedness to be incurred here-
15 under during the year nineteen hundred and four
16 shall not exceed the sum of eighty thousand dol-
17 lars, and the bonds, notes or scrip to be issued
18 therefor shall be dated May first, nineteen hun-
19 dred and four, and shall be denominated on their
20 face "Brockton High School Loan, 1904."

21 The securities authorized to be issued here-
22 under shall be signed by the mayor and city
23 treasurer, and shall bear interest at a rate not
24 exceeding four per centum per annum, payable
25 semi-annually. The issue of the year nineteen
25 hundred and three shall be paid in twenty annual
27 proportionate payments of not more than five
28 thousand dollars each, and the first of said pay-
29 ments shall be made on the first day of May in
30 the year nineteen hundred and four. The issue
31 of the year nineteen hundred and four shall be
32 paid in twenty annual proportionate payments of
33 not more than four thousand dollars each, and
34 the first of said payments shall be made on the
35 first day of May, in the year nineteen hundred
36 and five.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
